Other special entertainment and displays will include Tudor Juggler Hattie Hyder, Beekeeping, plus Byfleet Boat Club and "Henry VIII" will be travelling along the River Wey on Saturday 14th September to pay a special visit to Woking Palace at about midday. Also on Saturday afternoon there will be a dance display by Thames Valley Morris Men.

Volunteers from the Friends of Woking Palace will provide information throughout the weekend with displays about the history of the site, including archaeology and artefacts from recent excavations, and children's activities. They will also take guided tours round Woking Palace throughout both days, as and when required, with the final tours at 4pm. All free but donations very welcome.

Guidebooks, CDs and postcards, along with a number of other publications, will be on sale in the on-site pavilion.

Please note: Free long-stay parking is available in Old Woking, in the larger car park (beyond the smaller short-stay area) by the mini roundabout at the junction of A247 and B382.
